2. Declaration of interests this agenda - none
3. Minutes of previous meeting - agreed and signed
13. Slip Road A1101 Flempton - only sketch plan received, provisional plan cost £5,000. Meeting open 7.35pm - 7.55pm - concern expressed about cost to Parish, letter to be sent to Parish Council signed by at least 12 electors to express their concerns. To be considered at the next meeting.
4. Payments due - Suffolk Acre insurance renewal as agreed in new five year payment plan, agreed payment D Deeks for internal audit. No payment for external audit.
5. to accept Statement of Assurance and annual review internal audit system - agreed
6. Approve and accept Annual Return 2014/2015 - accept, no concerns, put up in notice boards.
7. Suffolk Association of Local Councils - nothing new
8. Borough Council - reinstate Footpath, ? Field Gate being repaired. Riverbank path will be repaired before Christmas. Funding for this major repair is being provided by Suffolk County Council, the County Councillor's Locality budget, with the majority of the funding coming from Perennial Gardeners Royal Benevolent Society (Fullers Mill) and Suffolk Wild Life Trust. Rangers plan to next meeting. Brown Bins will be charged to empty ? from April 2016. West Stow Country Park - application for 100 camping places + a few caravans. Guy Smith will provide an action plan for pot holes.
9. County Council - Pot holes, beside the A1101 on path dangerous, no parking sign on foot path. Rebecca will follow up with action plan and time scale. Slip road more details needed, Rebecca has received 2 letters of objection. ? highways joint public meeting.
10. Police - report received - Cockerel gone in Hengrave, burglaries - empty houses being targeted.
11. Broadband - ? 2017 mobiles bad, may need to upgrade own equipment.


